We are preparing to do a great deal of work in the coming months. While the majority of Douglas County's recreational parks have been remodeled, updated and brought up to current safety measures, Bill Arp Park has not. We do not have the available funds through the county to complete this project. Our goal is to return Bill Arp Park to a park that Douglas County can be proud of.

We know that many citizens of Douglas County spent their youth and started their love of baseball, softball, football and cheerleading at this park. We are asking for your help! We are also asking local businesses for donations of materials and labor. If you are a local business and are willing to help us with any of the donations listed below, please make us aware of which area you are available to contribute. We will be accepting sports equipment, project donations, and monetary contributions.

Restoration goals include:

Sod and resurfacing fields, painting or replacing field fencing, adding field safety nets, replacing or updating the batting cages and providing safety netting, resurfacing ground area in batting cages, updating the concessions stand kitchen to meet current safety standards, replacing concessions equipment, constructing outdoor grilling area with safety wall surround or fencing, replacing bleachers for baseball fields, updating dugout, updating bathrooms and replacing the damaged baseball banner. Revitalizing our playground for our younger children.

Material Donations needed:

***Sod and Infield material**

***Paint and equipment (bathrooms and concession interior-walls and floor, possibly painting rusted fencing)**

*** Commercial Concession Stand equipment**

***Fencing material (replace rusting field fencing and wood fencing for concession grilling area)**

***Wood materials to construct a safety surround for the grill area**

***Printing banners**

*** Tumbling Pads for our cheerleaders**

***Any type practice equipment (baseballs, pitching machines, pitchers practice screens, dugout organizers / helmet caddies)**

*** Bleachers**
